Submission Instructions:

Two copies of the abstract should be submitted electronically as a "Word" document via the online Poster Abstract form on the Poster Presentation webpage on the IAND website (<u>Click Here</u>). The abstracts should be a brief (300-word limit) description of the ideas or concepts to be presented including relevance to dietetic practice or research.

First Copy: Blinded

The document that corresponds to this should have all identifying information of authors, program or project removed so that the abstracts can be reviewed in a blinded fashion.

The blinded copy of the abstract should have an electronic file name starting with "bl." and include one or two key words from the title.

Second Copy: Non-Blinded

The non-blinded copy of the abstract should include the same key words from the title in the electronic file name (no author names) without the "bl" preface. The document that corresponds should include the authors' names, credentials, professional affiliation, complete title and abstract.

Example Labeling

Title of the abstract is "Motivational Interviewing in Teens with Diabetes" Blinded electronic file name: "bl.MotivationalInterview.doc". Non-blinded abstract document for the example above should be: "MotivationalInterview.doc".

Criteria for scoring:

1. Relevance: Clear purpose of project/program, appropriateness, timeliness, audience intrigue.

- 2. Priority: Recognized precedent; cutting edge concern.
- 3. Originality: Uniqueness of topic or format.
- 4. Synthesis: Evaluation and summary of report findings or applications.
- 5. Methodology: Clear research design with potential application for future research.
